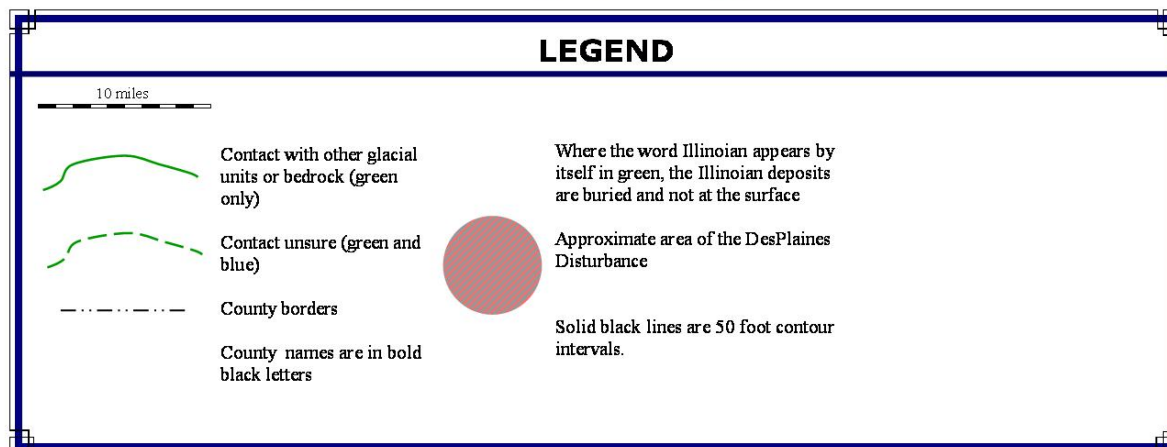
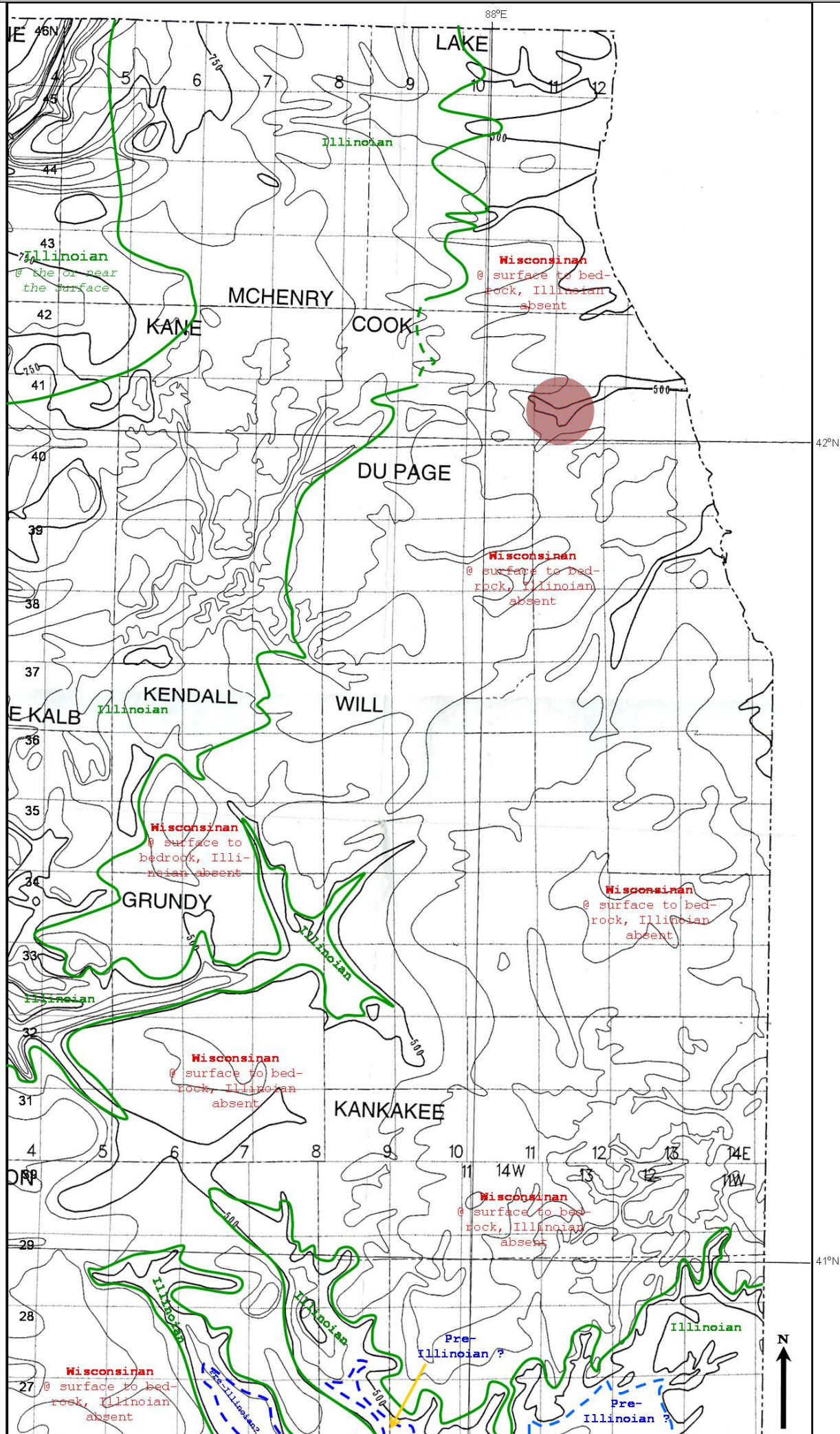


# Map of Extent of Buried Illinoian Glacial Deposits in Northeastern Illinois



**NOTES:**

Illinoian units are buried by Wisconsinan deposits unless otherwise noted. The extent of the Pre-Illinoian is still unclear. If it is present in the area it exists only buried beneath the Illinoian, in the Southern part of the mapping area and would be the oldest glacial deposits in the state.

The two most common occurring subsurface Illinoian units in the area are the Oregon Formation (diamiction) and the Peral Formation (outwash). Where the Illinoian deposits are buried they are overlain by the Wisconsinan deposits.
