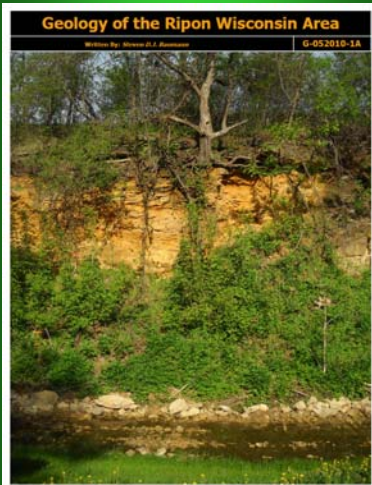

NEWS

MIGE has released one large publication. "Geology of the Ripon Wisconsin Area (G-052010-1A)" Included in the Ripon report is 27 pages focusing on the local bedrock geology. The field work has lead to the discovery of several bedrock structures. Accompanying the report are two large bedrock maps. One is a Surficial map and the second is a Surficial map with subsurface bedrock units. This report and maps will be the first large project released for free on the MIGE website.

Also several small outcrop description publications are in the works. Detailed outcrops in Iowa, Ontario, and Wisconsin are in the works and will be available in the near future.

There is some bad news. The INDI MAP project has been postponed until 2012 due to budget and time constraints. MIGE will keep the public updated on the INDI MAP project as new news arrives.

EVENTS

MIGE has no immediate events scheduled within the next few months. However, the second "Earthquake Seminar" is being planned.

MIGE is currently working on several projects. Mostly outcrop descriptions throughout the Midwest. Also Ripon has been completed and will be available soon on the website.

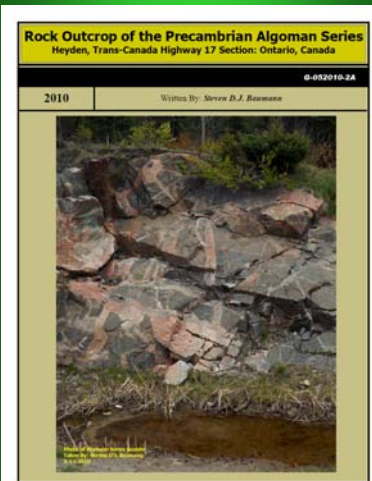
Castle Rock State Park will be released in the near future as soon as the ISGS completes the geologic map of the Oregon Quadrangle in Illinois.

The project called "The Water Replenishment Project" is still on the board for 2012 release.



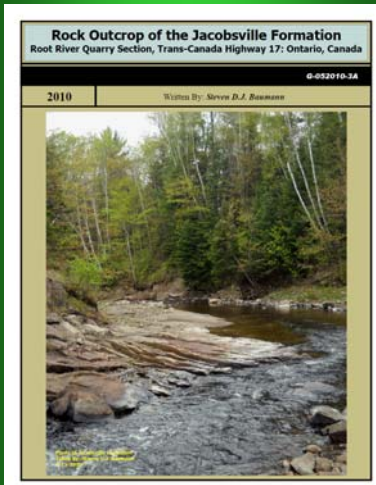
